On the occasion of the beatification of Adele de Batz de Trenquelléon, founder of the Daughters of Mary Immaculate (Marianist Sisters), next June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018, the Marianist Sisters announce a Photography Contest:

### **“LOOKING AT THE WORLD WITH ADELE'S EYES”.**

**What would Adele look at if she went through our streets, our schools, the countries where the Marianist Family is present after these 200 years, or the places where there is not Marianist presence yet?**

**Look around and focus your camera on something that you think would catch Mother Adele's attention. Give it a title and write a message that relates the image to the life and spirit of our Founder.**

### **OBJECTIVES**

The main objectives of this initiative are to:

- Spread the life of Blessed Adele de Batz and the mission of the Marianist Sisters throughout the world.
- Involve the entire International Marianist Family in portraying the current and intercultural nature of the Marianist charism.
- Train our vision to see with Gospel eyes: discovering the Good News in our world today (ie. What is positive, supportive, compassionate, cheerful, building peace and friendship, defending the truth, and what is denouncing injustice).
- Publish selected works by digital or print means.

### **RULES & GUIDELINES**

**Category A:** Youth from 12 to 17 years old, who are students of Marianist schools around the world.

**Category B:** Adults (anyone 18 or over) belonging to any branches of the Marianist Family, including students, staff working in any Marianist Institution or project, parents of students, and any person related to or collaborating with the Marianist mission in the world.

- 👁 Each participant can enter one to a maximum of three photographs, taken with a camera or mobile device.
- 👁 Photos must be original and unpublished (ie. not been previously published in any media form).
- 👁 No photograph may be presented whose intellectual property rights do not belong entirely and solely to the contest participant.
- 👁 It is the responsibility of the photographer/entrant to have the authorization and permission for distribution and publication of all people that appear in the photograph.
- 👁 **Photographs must be a minimum size of 1MB and a maximum of 4 MB, and be submitted in JPG format.**
- 👁 Photographs should be sent by email to: [concorso.adele@fmi-adele.org](mailto:concorso.adele@fmi-adele.org).

- 👁️ Include in the body of the message the following information:
    - First Name and Last Name of the photographer/entrant
    - Age (if under 18). If under 18, please ensure parent/guardian/sponsor have read rules and give permission.
    - Nationality (Country)
    - Relationship or Role with the Marianist Family
    - Contact Full mailing address (street number and name, city, state/country, postal/zip code) and email address.
    - For each photograph that is submitted, include:
      - Title of the photograph
      - Description of the Photograph (maximum 75 words)
  - 👁️ The official languages of the contest will be Spanish, Italian, English and French. The title and description of the photograph must be written in one of these four languages.
  - 👁️ The description can include quotes from Mother Adele's letters. Judges will reward creativity and the ability to interpret today's reality in light of the life and spirit of Mother Adele.

**Contest Deadline: Works can be submitted up to May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2018.** Photographs sent after the deadline will not be accepted.

The Marianist Sisters reserve the right to publish the photographs selected on the web page of the Congregation of Daughters of Mary Immaculate (<https://www.fmi-adele.org>) and to include the contestant's name and nationality.

**Awards: (in Euros)**

Category A:

- First Prize: 600€
- Second Prize: 400€
- Third prize: 300€

Category B:

- First Prize: 600€
- Second Prize: 400€
- Third prize: 300€



- 👁️ In the case of low or no participation or photograph quality not meeting minimum expectations, the committee reserves the right to not award a prize in the category.
- 👁️ Prizes will be issued in Euros. Any expenses resulting from the transfer of the prize or currency exchange will be borne by the winner.

**Judging:**

- 👁️ The judging team will be the Marianist Sisters who work as Assistants for Education in each Unit of the Congregation, chaired by the General Assistant for Education.

**Prize-Winners:**

- 👁️ The winners of the competition will be announced before June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018, the date of the beatification of Adela de Batz de Trenquelléon. Winners will be communicated with by email, through the same email address given at the time of submission. Receipt and acceptance of the prize must be acknowledged to the Organizer within 3 days. If we do not receive a response from the finalist after 3 days, the prize may be transferred to another contestant.

- 👁️ Participation implies the free cession of rights of reproduction and public communication on the images in favor of the Contest Organizer, without territorial or temporal limitation on them. It also implies a free cession under the same conditions, of the right to modify or partially adapt the image for its inclusion in any type of printed material or digital media, without right in any case, to any remuneration.
- 👁️ Photographs submitted can be used by the Organizer through any means and using any method; ie. either through internet, photographic exhibitions, magazines, books or other digital or similar advertising materials.
- 👁️ The organization also reserves the right not to use the photographs.
- 👁️ Any participant who submits a work whose rights of intellectual property were legitimately claimed by third parties, will also be the sole and exclusive one responsible for the claims received by the organizer, exempting the Organizer from any liability arising from its use.

We look forward to your entries and viewing your creativity. May the Spirit guide your discoveries of our world today as seen with Adele's eyes and spirit.
